Note from Mr Haley – We have sent out a questionnaire about school lunches. We would appreciate your views (and your child's) on our meals - please let us have returns by 12th July. School Disco Volunteers: We welcome parent volunteers to help run the upcoming school disco. If you would like to help on this occasion a DBS check will not be necessary as volunteers will be supervised. We only require a DBS check for volunteers who are in on a regular basis.

Sports Days: Please note the **changes to the sports days' timings!**

On Monday 16th July lower KS2 (Years 3 & 4) will be having their sports day from 9.30am. Upper KS2 (Years 5 & 6) from 12.30pm. On Tuesday 17th July Early Years and KS1 will have their sports day from 12.30pm – all sports events are subject to change dependent on the weather! **Could all KS2 parents please provide 4 safety pins for each of their children for school games day.**

Early Years Show: The end of Early Years' show to families is on Friday 20th July at 9:30am. All are welcome to join us in the hall for songs and smiles as we watch our EY children finish their 'EYFS' experience.

Early Years' Trip: The Early Years' trip to the farm is on Monday 2nd July – 9.10am until 3pm. As a one-off we will open the doors 5 mins early so that we can leave promptly. The children need a rucksack as well as water, hats and suncream. It is advisable to wear similar clothes to forest schools (school t-shirt, any long legged trousers and comfortable walking shoes).

Reading Café: The next Reading Café is for 1JC – Monday 2nd July at 2pm, please arrive a few minutes before to allow for signing in – and weather permitting we will hold it in the 'Quiet Garden'. Free refreshments provided.

Late Arrivals: Please ensure if your child has a medical appointment or is late arriving at school for any reason that you come to the Reception and sign **all** children in on the digital screen – we have had occasions when parents have returned 3 children but only signed in one. If your child does not appear either on the register or on our signing in list we are obliged to telephone you and check on your child's whereabouts.

Pop In Café: On Friday 6th July we have our 3rd Pop-In Café here at St Mary's . We will be sharing strategies on how to cope with our children's friendship worries and how we can support them. The café runs from 9am til 10am – with free tea/coffee and biscuits – all welcome.

Bikeability: All Year 5 children who are undertaking bikeability training - your bikes need to be in school next week from Monday - Thursday (in fully working order), you will need a helmet at school, and can wear joggers/jeans/trainers if you prefer so you are comfortable. School tshirts and jumpers should still be worn so you can be easily identified when we are on the roads. Parents: Please make sure they are ready for the British weather (sun cream and rain coats).

The Eco council: We are busy promoting the use of canvas bags rather than plastic bags. EY and KS1 children will have the opportunity to buy a bag with their class on. KS2 children will be able to enter a competition for a bag design to promote one of the School eco values. Watch out for details of how to enter next week.
