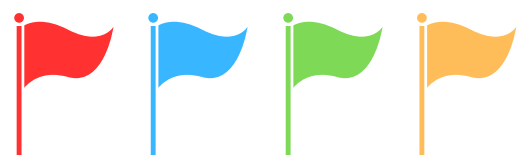
HOUSE TEAMS!:

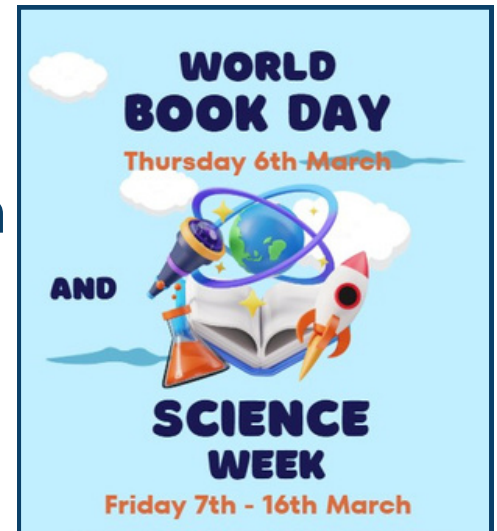


World Book Day | Science Week | 6th March and 7th – 16th March
