



Early Years Tour for 2026/2027 | 4th to 7th November




During our first week back after the half term break, we welcomed families who have children starting Early Years in September 2026 to view our school. It was lovely to see new faces as well as families who already have children here.




Parent Coffee Morning for Anxious Children | 28th November


